

COVID information for ERASMUS program participants coming to the UCT Prague Residence Halls as well as for all the other residents

In order to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection in the UCT Prague Residence Halls, the following increased hygiene measures are to be followed and taken:

- 1) The shared areas of the Residence Halls are regularly cleaned in accordance with cleaning standards using virucidal disinfectants, this primarily applies to entrance halls, lifts, stairs, shared kitchens and common sanitary facilities). In particular, the frequency of surfaces cleaned with disinfectants shall increase, especially the surfaces such as handles, handrails on stairs, elevators, etc.,
- 2) Stands with a hand disinfectant have been installed at the entrance to the Sázava and Volha Residence Halls,
- 3) ***All persons accommodated in the Residence Halls of the UCT Prague moving in the common areas of the Residence Halls need to wear a protective mask covering the nose and mouth and, in particular, to observe increased hand hygiene. Also, it is necessary to keep a physical distance of at least 2 meters from other people,***
- 4) ***Persons accommodated in the Sázava and Volha Residence Halls / UCT Prague are not allowed to gather in groups in the common areas of the Residence Halls (in shared kitchens, corridors on the floors of the Residence Halls, etc.) or in the rooms of the accommodated students. There is a strict ban on holding parties in rooms, the violation of which is qualified by the Police of the Czech Republic as a violation of the law with a fine for individuals amounting to 10,000 CZK and resulting in the termination of the relevant Contract for Accommodation in the UCT Prague Residence Halls,***
- 5) All persons coming from abroad or persons who are accommodated in the Residence Halls of the UCT Prague, regardless of whether they came into contact with an infected person or a person who returned from infected areas abroad, if showing signs of even mild symptoms of the COVID-19 disease, shall immediately notify the Residence Hall Manager by telephone and e-mail to ubytovani@vscht.cz. The resident in question will then pack their personal and necessary belongings and wait for further instructions to move to quarantine. The accommodated person then immediately contacts their attending physician or hygienic station for Prague 4 by phone +420 241 010 346-8 or +420 735 726 556,
- 6) Persons placed in quarantine are obliged to observe the quarantine measures for a period of 14 days, or according to the instructions (received from a hygienic station or a doctor). In the event of a decision on the premature termination of the quarantine of the accommodated person, the accommodated person must provide a copy of the relevant document to the Manager of the respective Sázava or Volha Residence Hall,

Furthermore, these persons are obliged:

- a) not to leave their assigned quarantine room,
- b) not to move freely around the shared areas of the Residence Halls,
- c) to observe increased hygiene measures, especially hand hygiene,
- d) to use disposable paper towels or tea towels,
- e) to use a face mask, respirator, or other covers of the mouth and nose.

7) Rules of quarantine for UCT Prague Residence Halls

It is absolutely necessary to observe increased hygiene measures, especially hand hygiene. Persons under quarantine must use a face mask when it comes to contact with other persons, do not approach persons at a distance of less than two meters, avoid physical contact, and use disinfection. Quarantined persons are not allowed to enter the common areas of the Residence Halls (e.g. study room, canteen, kitchen, etc.). Quarantined persons may not go on visits and may not receive any visits. Persons in quarantine are required to monitor their health, in case of health problems (symptoms of coronavirus disease - body temperature of 37.5 °C and above, dry cough, joint pain, migraine, shortness of breath) or any deterioration of their health, they must contact their doctor immediately and then also report this information to the Manager of the Sázava or Volha Residence Hall, in which they are accommodated: sazava@vscht-suz.cz or volha@vscht-suz.cz;

In case of acute health problems, contact emergency line 155 immediately.

Persons in quarantine will discuss with the Residence Hall Management or their roommates possibilities of how to secure their necessary purchases and meals.

Quarantined persons who need to leave the Residence Hall (only in case of virus testing at the designated place) must always wear a face mask or other nose and mouth cover, wash their hands thoroughly or use disposable rubber gloves before leaving the room. They must also keep a distance of at least two meters away from other people.
