

## Director's Regulation effective from 25. 3. 2020

## Discount on Residence Hall Accommodation from 1.4.2020

Due to the emergency situation and after agreeing with our University Management, Residence Hall Board and representatives of students, I have decided to take the following measures:

- 1) The accommodation fee shall be discounted by 20% effective from 1.4.2020 until further notice.
- 2) The discount exclusively applies to the students of UCT Prague who are accommodated in UCT Prague Residence Halls.
- 3) The previous regulation from 23.3.2020 on the possibility of early termination of accommodation contracts without a cancellation fee, etc. remains valid and in effect.

I also need to point out that the mode of the accommodation in UCT Residence Halls based on the Accommodation Contract does not (and cannot) individually distinguish which residents actually use their accommodation more or less frequently or who consumes more or less water, energy, etc. That is also the reason why the accommodation fee discount cannot be realised in a somewhat more gradual or differentiating manner.

For the reasons given above, the blanket discount just introduced may not be ideal but we consider it the easiest solution which can be realised swiftly under the given exceptional circumstances.

I expect that this emergency regulation (just as the previous one) will be viewed and accepted as a helpful supportive step taken on our behalf and I look forward to the moment where no such or other emergency provisions will be needed any longer.
