

Director's Regulation Effective from 12.5.2020

Prolongation of Accommodation Contracts

Owing to the extended exam period (and possibly other study obligations), the students having their accommodation contracts concluded for this academic year (i.e. valid until 26.6.2020) are offered a possibility to prolong their accommodation contracts.

To be able to do so, it is necessary to fill in and submit the Application for Summer Accommodation no later than on 29.5.2020. The Application needs to state clearly the date to which the students wish or need to prolong their current accommodation contracts.

Based on the submitted Applications, the corresponding accommodation contracts shall be prolonged automatically (neither amendments to current contracts nor new contracts need to be concluded in this case). The accommodation fee for the prolonged accommodation period shall be the same as that of the standard accommodation.

The prolonged period of the accommodation contracts may not exceed 10.7.2020.

The accommodation for June and the start of July (up to the calendar date in accordance with the students' requirements) needs to be paid via a credit card or in cash at the cash desk located in the Accommodation Department of the Sázava Residence Hall by 25.6.2020 at the latest (*note: since the accommodation fee is paid retroactively and the payment must be realised before an accommodation contract expires and the respective students move out, the last payment cannot be made in the form of direct debiting from your bank account*).
